Wise Payment Systems, Inc. ("WPS") Privacy Principles

All of our consumers and businesses rely on WPS for safe and reliable payment services. Our relationships are established based on mutual trust. Each day, we strive to reinforce our commitment to our business customers and consumers.

In order to provide these services, WPS must collect, maintain and use financial and other sensitive personal information.

WPS' Privacy Principles guide us in the collection and use of information and reinforce the role our employees play in protecting consumer privacy.

Our business customers may adopt other principles applicable to their collection and use of information or simply customize these principles.

WPS may modify its policies as appropriate for particular products and services or to comply with local laws and regulatory requirements around the world.

WPS Privacy Principles

1. WE OBTAIN PERSONAL INFORMATION THAT IS NEEDED TO PROVIDE OUR GOODS AND SERVICES.

We primarily receive personal information as a result of consumers' financial transactions with business customers of WPS or a WPS processing customer. Generally, WPS does not obtain personal information directly from consumers. However, in the event WPS collects information directly from consumers, we will obtain the personal information that is needed to provide our goods or services, to provide customer service and to fulfill any legal or regulatory requirements. When we obtain information about consumers from third parties, we use reputable sources, including public repositories.

2. WE WILL INFORM CONSUMERS ABOUT THE GENERAL USES OF THEIR INFORMATION.

Generally, WPS does not have a direct customer relationship with consumers. However, in the event we have a direct relationship with consumers, we will strive to make information available to them about the general uses of the information that we collect. Generally, WPS obtains personal information about consumers indirectly through our business customers and channels. To that end, we encourage our business customers and channels to provide these consumers with a timely and complete privacy notice.

3. WE ARE COMMITTED TO PROTECTING THE CONFIDENTIALITY OF PERSONAL CONSUMER INFORMATION.

Within WPS, access to personal information is limited to those employees of WPS and its affiliates who need it to fulfill their business responsibilities. Employees must adhere to WPS Privacy Principles. Violation of the Privacy Principles can result in disciplinary action up to and including dismissal.

When WPS collects information on behalf of our business customers and alliances, we handle the information based on their direction and in accordance with our agreements and contracts with them and applicable laws.

Vendors and other outside contractors we engage are subject to our contractual requirements to ensure sensitive personal information is safeguarded. For purposes of credit reporting, verification and risk management, we may share information about consumers with third parties. We will also disclose consumer information in response to a lawful request issued by a court, government agency or regulatory authority with the jurisdiction to make that request.

4. WE STRIVE TO GIVE CONSUMERS CHOICES ABOUT HOW THEIR DATA WILL BE USED.

If we obtain personal information as part of a direct relationship with consumers, we will not share this information with non-affiliated third parties except in accordance with these Privacy Principles; to provide products and services; to facilitate and complete consumer-initiated or authorized transactions and service requests; to comply with federal, state and local laws, including credit reporting laws and card association rules; to combat fraud or identity theft; or to offer products and services that WPS believes may be of interest to its customers.

5. WE USE APPROPRIATE SECURITY SAFEGUARDS.

At WPS, security is a priority. We employ appropriate measures to protect consumer information against unauthorized access, disclosure, alteration or destruction. These may include, among other things, encryption, physical access security, computer firewalls and other appropriate technologies. WPS reviews and enhances its security systems, as necessary.
